

Leading the development of National and State-level HWC mitigation guidelines for Karnataka, West Bengal, and Uttarakhand, and developing SOPs for selected species and issues. Draft of the National Human - Wildlife Conflict Mitigation Strategy and Action Plan and selected SOPs

- Regional Stakeholder consultation workshops
- ◆ A common framework for state-level HWC action plans
- Draft state level strategy and action plans for three States
- Consultation workshops to discuss the state-level action plans

Development of database on human wildlife conflict in India

- ◆ A format for data monitoring through a consultative workshop
- ◆ Centralized database on a GIS platform
- ◆ Central database showing data inputs from the three states- Karnataka, West Bengal and Uttarakhand

Specialized field studies at the project pilot sites in Karnataka, West Bengal and Uttarakhand

- Detailed document providing overview of the studies/surveys with key outputs
- A document on specific recommendations for state and national level strategy and action plan.

Implementation of training and other capacity development measures engaging key stakeholders

- Curriculum and training material on HWC for key stakeholders including field level staff and senior IFS officers
- Customized modules on HWC Mitigation under the Diploma & certificate courses being offered at WII
- A new one-week special module on HWC Mitigation for a multi-stakeholder group
- Training of Trainers (ToTs) to develop HWC mitigation specific skill-sets
