Question 1. What is the reason behind not mentioning 'minimum 60% marks obtained in the Masters' Degree' criteria for the positions entitled 'Research Biologists' in the above mentioned advertisement? Whereas in previous advertisements (2014-15) for 'Research Biologists' (by Wildlife Institute of India) the criteria were kept as 'minimum 60% marks obtained in the Masters' Degree'. Given the nature of work and depth of knowledge/expertise required for these long term projects (especially for Bandhavgarh tiger ecology project), it's very unlikely to have no lower limit of marks obtained in the MSc for these positions.

Question 2. What is the 'minimum marks obtained in the Masters' Degree' criteria for positions entitled 'Research Biologists' in the above mentioned advertisement? These positions seem to be similar of 'Project Biologists' and 'Project Assistants' positions (by fellowship, age limits and age relaxation). Although there is no mention of minimum marks obtained in Masters' Degree in 'Research Biologists' positions, which is 'minimum of 60% aggregate marks' for 'Project Biologists' and 'Project Assistants' positions.
